The City of South Fulton, Georgia, has a rich history and a distinct personality. Several historic settlements are part of this **2017** incorporation, which grew out of portions of southwest Fulton County. The city's story reflects its cultural significance, progress, and autonomy.

Historical Context

The Creek and Cherokee people were the first to live in what is now South Fulton. Candler Field, originally an auto racing circuit, later transformed into Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, occupied a section of what would later develop into South Fulton in the early 20th century.

Establishment and Growth

On May 1, 2017, South Fulton officially established itself as the largest newly incorporated city in Georgia. Over 100,000 residents inhabit the city, which spans nearly 100 square miles.


Economic and Social Landscape

The city boasts a homeownership rate of 69%, one of the highest in the United States across various demographics, and it also has a median income that surpasses that of Atlanta.

Prominent residents of South Fulton comprise Grammy Award-winning artists Kandi Burruss and Ludacris, along with the late Civil Rights leader John Lewis.

Aerotropolis Nature Park: 2968 Butner Road, South Fulton, GA 30331

The city recently opened the Aerotropolis Nature Park, which offers over three miles of mountain biking trails and a skills course with various obstacles. It also features a 2.5-mile figure-8 layout on a natural surface for multi-use hiking.

Trammell Crow Park: 4980 Cascade Road, South Fulton, GA 30331

Sports fans will love its multipurpose field, perfect for spontaneous frisbee or soccer matches. Because of its adaptability, the park is a focal point for outdoor recreation and community events and features a walking and nature trail.

Fitness enthusiasts will appreciate the trail's gentle undulations, providing just enough challenge to elevate the heart rate while still being accessible to visitors of all fitness levels. 




Exploring the City of South Fulton's Outdoor Adventures

Preserving the Legacy: the City of South Fulton's Cultural & Historical Gems

- *Old National Highway* is a historic route with a strong economic and cultural legacy. It has long been a vital route linking areas south of Atlanta, spanning portions of Fulton and Clayton counties. The highway's transformation from a rural road to a busy commercial and residential corridor is noteworthy.
- Owl Rock Methodist Church is one of Georgia's oldest, having been established in 1828. The
 church's importance is increased by the part it plays in the local Black community's spiritual lives,
 especially after the Civil War. It provided a haven where recently liberated African Americans
 could congregate, engage in spirituality, and strengthen their feeling of belonging in an
 environment still severely damaged by racial hostilities.
- *The Red Oak District* is known for its 172-year historic contribution to local trade and community growth accounts for its historical relevance that began in the 1850s.
- From its beginnings as a Native American colony to its evolution into a thriving African American community, *the Sandtown neighborhood* is a live example of the many historical facets that have shaped it. It represents the larger themes of the Black experience in the South, which are resilience, displacement, and the desire for self-determination.

Transportation


- City of South Fulton shares borders with the City of Atlanta which allows for access to a variety of transportation options.
